The NAD Social Studies Textbook Review Committee, which met in June 2018, was composed of five secondary Social Studies teachers and three Union secondary leaders. The committee considered textbooks from three publishers: Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, McGraw-Hill, and Pearson.

Committee Observations:

- Textbooks are listed in order of the committee's preference
- Textbooks are aligned with recognized state and/or national literacy/history standards
- All reviewed textbooks are available online and in eText format
- Textbooks can be accessed through eReader apps (iOS/Android)
- Companies emphasize a wide range of digital resources embedded into their eText
- All publishers provide audio features for digital textbooks
- All reviewed textbooks include clear differentiated instruction activities
- All reviewed textbooks utilize text chunking and single-context processing techniques
- All reviewed textbooks offer assessments and data collection features (digital)
- Textbook purchases include ongoing training and technical support
- All reviewed textbooks incorporate current events (digital)
- Audio/Read-along with various voices for text reading (digital)


